You know your kid best! Please help us keep our kids healthy 😊

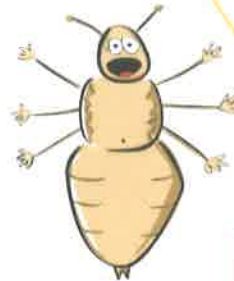


### Head Lice

**Look for:** Itchy head, live lice on scalp, behind ears and near neckline

**What to do?** Call your doctor for special shampoo recommendation. Vacuum couches. Wash with hot water and seal non washable items in bags for 2 weeks.
